#### Minnesota Livestock Breeders' Association Scholarships

Two scholarships are available.

One is the Minnesota Livestock Breeders' Association Scholarship and the other is the McKerrow Scholarship. Scholarships **must** be claimed within one year of awarding.

### Minnesota Livestock Breeders' Association Scholarship (MLBA)

The MLBA scholarship is \$750 or \$500 per school year and:

- Awarded to an outstanding present or former 4-H or FFA high school senior, entering an agricultural college for their first year, at either: University of Minnesota St. Paul or Crookston; University of Wisconsin River Falls; South Dakota State University; North Dakota State University; or Iowa State University.
- Must be pursuing a college education in which a major emphasis is on animal agriculture.

### **McKerrow Scholarship**

The McKerrow scholarship is \$500 per school year and:

- Awarded to a present or former 4-H member who is entering his or her sophomore, junior or senior year at the University of Minnesota St. Paul or Crookston.
- Must be a resident of Minnesota and majoring or minoring in Animal Science.
- A student may be awarded the McKerrow scholarship only once.
- The above stipulations are dictated by the terms of the agreement covering the trust of the McKerrow Scholarship Fund.
